





BOARD OF GOVERNORS

1982 will go down in the history of the College as the year it integrated with the State System. History will also record whether or not this change enhanced the "Catholic Character" of the school or was the first step towards a school indistinguishable from its State Counterpart. Catholic schools are not about reproducing what the State can offer but should offer a similar standard of education with the added dimension of teaching Christ's message in the certainty that there is more to this life than being successful and that there is a life hereafter.

This is the very real challenge facing the newly elected Board of Governors but not only them, but parents, pupils, friends, teachers, Parent Teacher Association and all associated with the school. Unless Catholic schools have that added dimension of Faith, then there is no point in having them.

The newly elected Board is gathering up the reins from past Boards and is conscious of the effort that they made to set Francis Douglas Memorial College to where it is today. It is also mindful of the sacrifices that have been made in the past, are being made now, and will be made in the future, by everybody connected with the College in whatever capacity. Whilst acknowledging our debt of gratitude, their best reward will be to see the College go from strength to strength, producing young men equipped with a faith that will enable them to face a world totally at variance with the Gospel message and not only survive but stand out as men of principle and integrity.

The start has been promising especially with the number allowing their names to go forward as candidates for election to the Board, denoting a keen interest in the future of the College. The elected Board has now met on several occasions and is coming to grips with its new task, but looks to the continued support of all associated with the College to ensure that what was started some twenty three years ago, will flourish and realise the aspirations of those who conceived the concept of a Catholic Boys College in Taranaki.

The process of becoming integrated is now over and we are beginning to learn to live with the consequences. Some of these we knew in advance but there are others which are only now becoming apparent.



I hope and pray that with the passage of years, the consequences of what we have done this year can be looked at in a favourable light and people will be able to say it was a wise move to make.


The degree to which they will be able to say that will depend upon how much we who now possess this college and those who follow us, believe in the value of Catholic Schools. If we are convinced that they are worthwhile then we will work to ensure that they survive and are truly Catholic.

This means the values of Christ and the Gospel must be evident in the way the school operates. If we claim to be Catholic, then the image must ring true, otherwise the hypocrisy of our position will be blatantly obvious. This is something in which all of us associated with the college can play a part. By our positive attitude and our involvement in the college we can assist in the building up of the Catholic character and can make this college a beacon of faith in this city and this country.

As more research is being done it is becoming very obvious that Catholic schools with a vibrant faith dimension do have a significant positive influence on their pupils. It is being shown that for many students the only experience of acceptance, compassion and love takes place in the classrooms of their schools. It is also becoming clear that student's perceptions of the school climate are having a unique positive effect upon the way they see their Christian faith and their awareness of social justice, independent of other influences. It would also appear that Catholic schools may have worked better than most people thought particularly in producing men and women of hope.

At this time when the very fabric of society is under threat we have good reason to have confidence in the value of Catholic schools and seek to ensure that they become more centred on Christ and the Gospel values.





When John Baptist De La Salle began the Brothers over 300 years ago, he faced a different world to the one we face but the values were very much the same. The great values continue to be wealth, pleasure, power and prestige. We need to ask ourselves whether these should be the values upper most in a Catholic school. As in the 17th century there are many people at present whose lives have no meaning, youth who have no hope for the future, we are trained to have rather than to be, we find ourselves in a throw away society conditioned to be efficient producers or avid consumers and there is no future for those who reject the great values.

De La Salle faced the same values and his message is as valid today as it was in the 17th century. De La Salle's message is not social revolution, not even an explanation of the world but a call to change it. The world is confronting us now as it did him and we are called to make a decision. Are we prepared to accept the challenge and in our schools, assist in the creation of a new man who will bring about such changes?

To do this we need to be like De La Salle, extremely sensitive to our surroundings in order to be able to understand their needs; our response springing from the experience of God working in our lives; vigorously opposed to fatalism and despair yet simple, modest and practical in our endeavours.



John Baptist De La Salle offered a future to the poor, spread the light of his love and fought without panic, living to the full even when everything seemed against him. Let us follow in his footsteps, alive with the vision of what a Catholic school can be, fighting for the dignity of every man and his right of self-development, living in solidarity among ourselves and serving our fellow men. If we do this we shall play our part in an contribute to the ultimate spiritual meaning of the work of our schools for justice and human development through education.

There are many things happening in this college which gives me great cause for hope, activities and developing attitudes which show we are continuing to move towards that ideal of a Catholic school. To all who have in any way assisted in that movement may I say a sincere thank you and I pray that the Lord will reward you and give you a deep sense of his presence with you.

Under Officer B. Christmas was presented for examination as outstanding cadet for the Central area. We await the result with a deal of confidence.





All Under Officers and NCO's worked unselfishly on all training days and deserve the Unit's gratitude.


