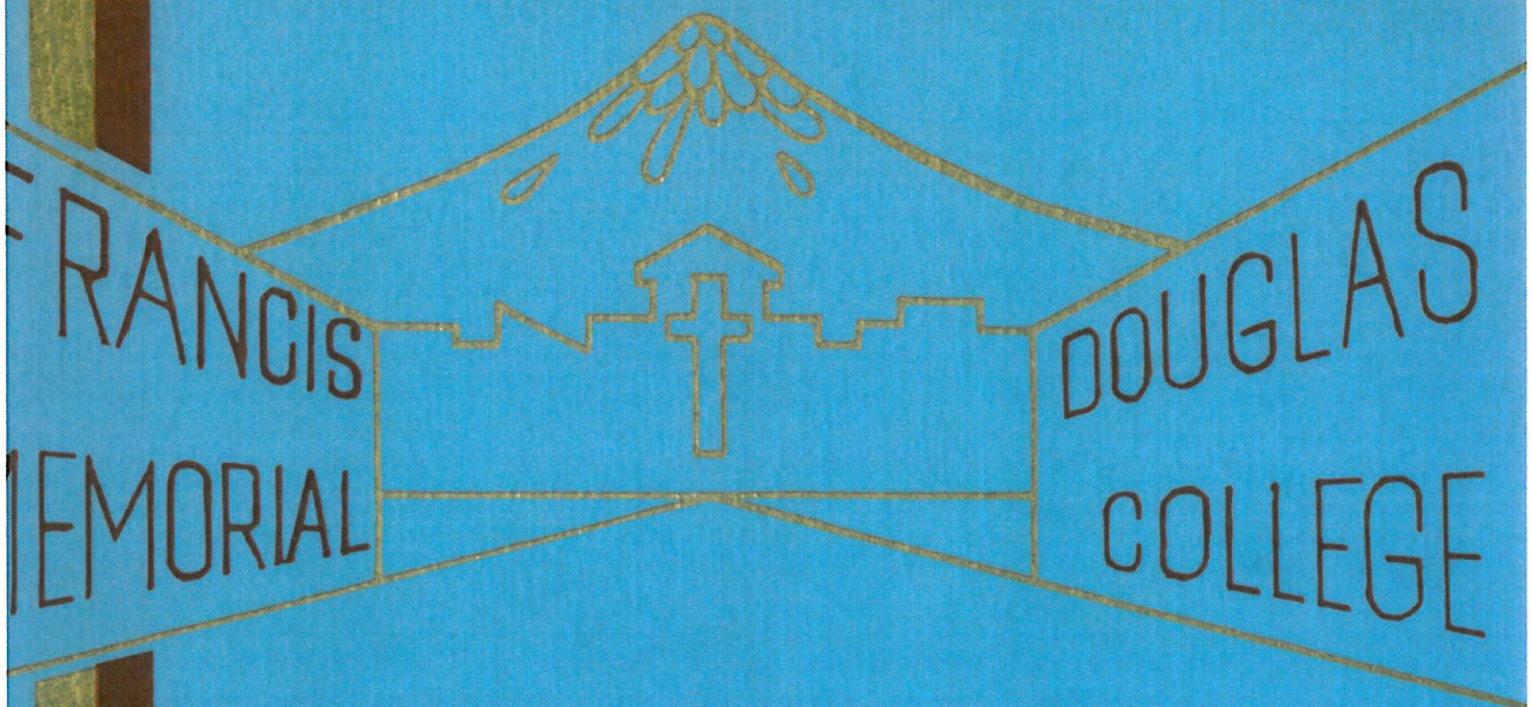

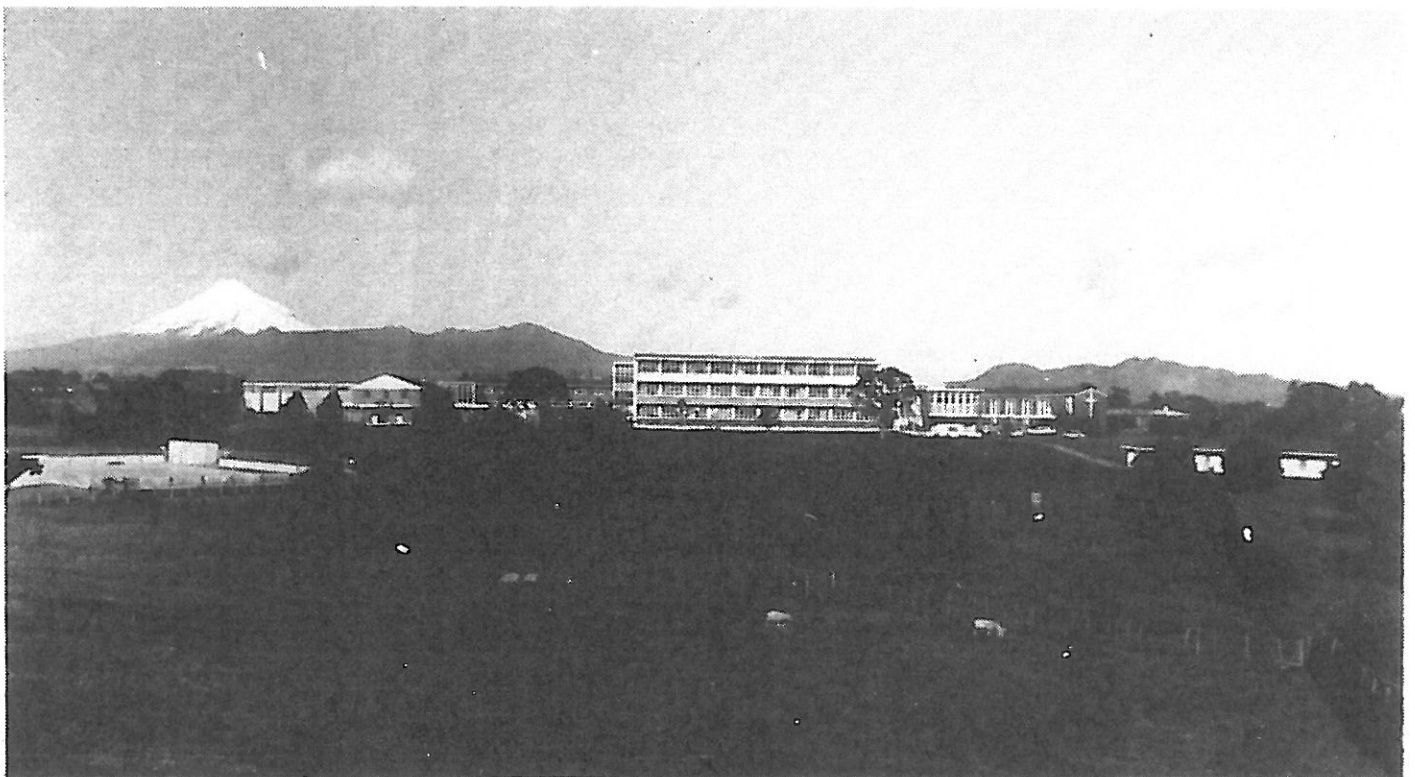

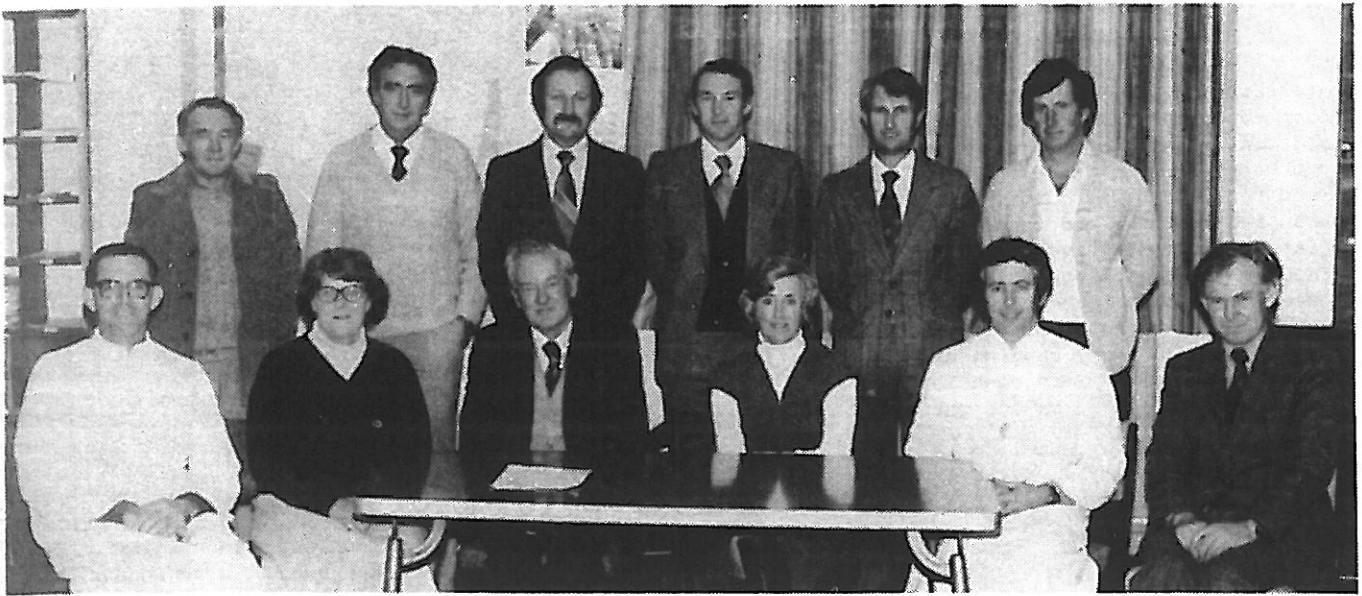

PRINCIPAL'S COMMENT

In celebrating 300 years of involvement with Catholic education, the Brothers this year passed an important milestone in their history. Just as St John Baptist De La Salle saw the needs of his time and followed God's guidance in responding to them, so the Brothers and those who have become associated with them, have sought to do the same. At Francis Douglas College this year attempts have been made to meet the needs of the boys that parents have entrusted to us. These needs are many and varied and are changing as conditions in society change. We are very conscious that the pressures the boys face now and when they leave school can lead to anxiety and fear.



One of the very real fears that is experienced by many young people about to leave school is the fear of not being able to find a satisfactory job. The education they have received, the qualifications they may have gained no longer hold any guarantees of entry to a position where they will be able to use their abilities in a satisfactory way. In justice to these young people efforts must be made by those responsible to ensure that young people's right to work is safeguarded. In what we do as a country and what we do as a school, there must be reflected the emphasis that people are the most important consideration. We as a College are not a job training institution but what we do should provide the opportunity for boys to become aware of and begin to develop their abilities so that they will be able to learn how to cope with a job they may be asked to do.

We are concerned with opening up possibilities for boys in as many fields as we can and allowing them to broaden their experience and realise their abilities. Obviously we hope this will provide a base so that skills which are needed for particular jobs can be developed when the boys obtain those jobs, but we are not restricting what we do here at the College to training boys for a particular job.



Because of the difficulty in obtaining jobs and the unrealistic demands that some employers make there is pressure on the College to become more job oriented. This, I feel, is something we must resist. If we become job oriented then the finer aspects of education can be lost in the race to do things which will be of 'use' in getting a job. Enormous pressure can also be put on boys to achieve unrealistic objectives which can definitely be detrimental to their growth. The backlash on society and the schools in particular when young people are denied the right to work can be devastating. Those people in a position to have influence have a great responsibility to ensure that the right of people to work is safeguarded. This is a matter of justice and justice is something central to what we are on about as Catholics.



We are fighting injustice ourselves by objecting to the treatment we are receiving from the Minister of Education. He is attempting to impose an unsatisfactory and discarded structure upon us and so delaying integration which is virtually beating us into submission. We must guard our rights because we will integrate but once and we must be mindful of those who come after us who will have to cope with the conditions on which we integrate. This is an area where there has been a great deal of activity but unfortunately not a great deal of progress.

These are some of the difficulties we face and we have to be realistic and deal with them, they will not go away if we pretend they are not there. At the same time, however, we must be very careful that we do not become an emergency orientated community always seeking to meet the immediate need at the expense of all else. In our dealing with the boys we must be careful that we are not catapulted along by one emergency after another. There is a great challenge to us as a Catholic College to hold out a sense of hope. We must bear witness to the hope to which we are called and not become immersed in the squallor of despair. We must remember we are seeking to be different, we are seeking to be Catholic, we are seeking to put Christ at the centre of the College, to make Him the reference point for all that happens here. Therefore we must not be afraid. We need to honestly work within the College and outside of it to promote justice, always conscious that we rest secure in the Lord's hands, that we are precious to Him.



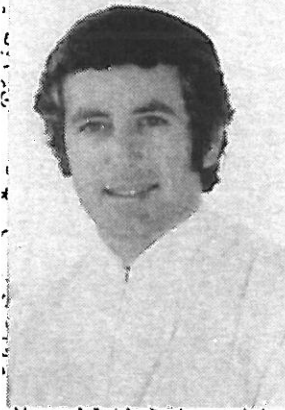
It is therefore of considerable satisfaction to reflect on the positive aspects of this year. In particular the vote of confidence that was given to the Catholic colleges of New Plymouth by the great response early this year to the Development Appeal. This was a tangible indication to us of your confidence in us and it was greatly appreciated. My plea is that the support and confidence be also there in the less tangible ways which make us different, that make us Catholic. This is also shown so obviously in our tercentenary celebrations when some 800 people attended the Mass to thank God for His blessings to the Brothers over the past 300 years. To all who have helped in any way to continue the work of St De La Salle may I say a sincere thank you. It is a great encouragement to realise the support that exists for what we are seeking to do here and I would again ask that we all work to identify and preserve the special character of our College, the special place that Christ must have here and the witness we must offer this city of being Christian.

CELEBRATING 300 YEARS



The Tercentenary of the De La Salle Brothers

This year the Brothers of the Christian Schools (known in many countries as the De La Salle Brothers) are offering public thanks to God for three centuries of continuous service in the Christian education of youth.

In the case of many enterprises of enduring worth , it is only in retrospect that their beginnings can be clearly marked.

When, in 1680, Canon John Baptist de La Salle of Rheims became inextricably involved with schools for the poor of his native city, he had no thought of launching a carefully thoughtout campaign designed to be prolonged through the centuries and spread to many distant countries. Indeed, he had no idea of what he was letting himself in for; and in later years he said that, had he known the difficulties the enterprise was to entail, he would not have touched it " with the tips of his fingers ". The work of John Baptist de La Salle prospered and took root because he had had the inspiration under God to form his teachers into a religious congregation of lay men exclusively dedicated to schools and Christian education.

So, despite the upheaval of the French Revolution and the bitter anti-clericalism of the last years of the nineteenth century in France and elsewhere; despite, also the two World Wars of the twentieth century, the work of the Institute of the Brothers of the Christian Schools still endures, and some 12 000 Brothers throughout the world pay allegiance to his memory and ideals.

John Baptist de La Salle was beatified in 1888 and canonised in 1900. Three of the Brothers are 'beati' : Blessed Solomon, martyr of the French Revolution, Blessed Miguel, a Spanish American, died 1909, and Blessed Mutien-Marie, a Belgian, died 1917; one is a canonised saint, Saint Benildus, a Frenchman, died 1861.

The Brothers are celebrating this year as the three hundredth anniversary of the foundation , since it was in 1680 that Canon de La Salle took the radical step of taking his raw group of school-masters into his own house; thus he joined community to apostolate and laid the foundations of a future religious congregation.

The Brothers hope and pray that these celebrations will be blessed, first by the evident renewal of the Brothers in their religious living and, secondly, by a manifest increase in the number of those young men presenting themselves for membership in the family of St. John Baptist de La Salle.
